A glowing five-point star with a sweet sleepy face. Two pieces, beginner-friendly, and great for garlands or keychains.

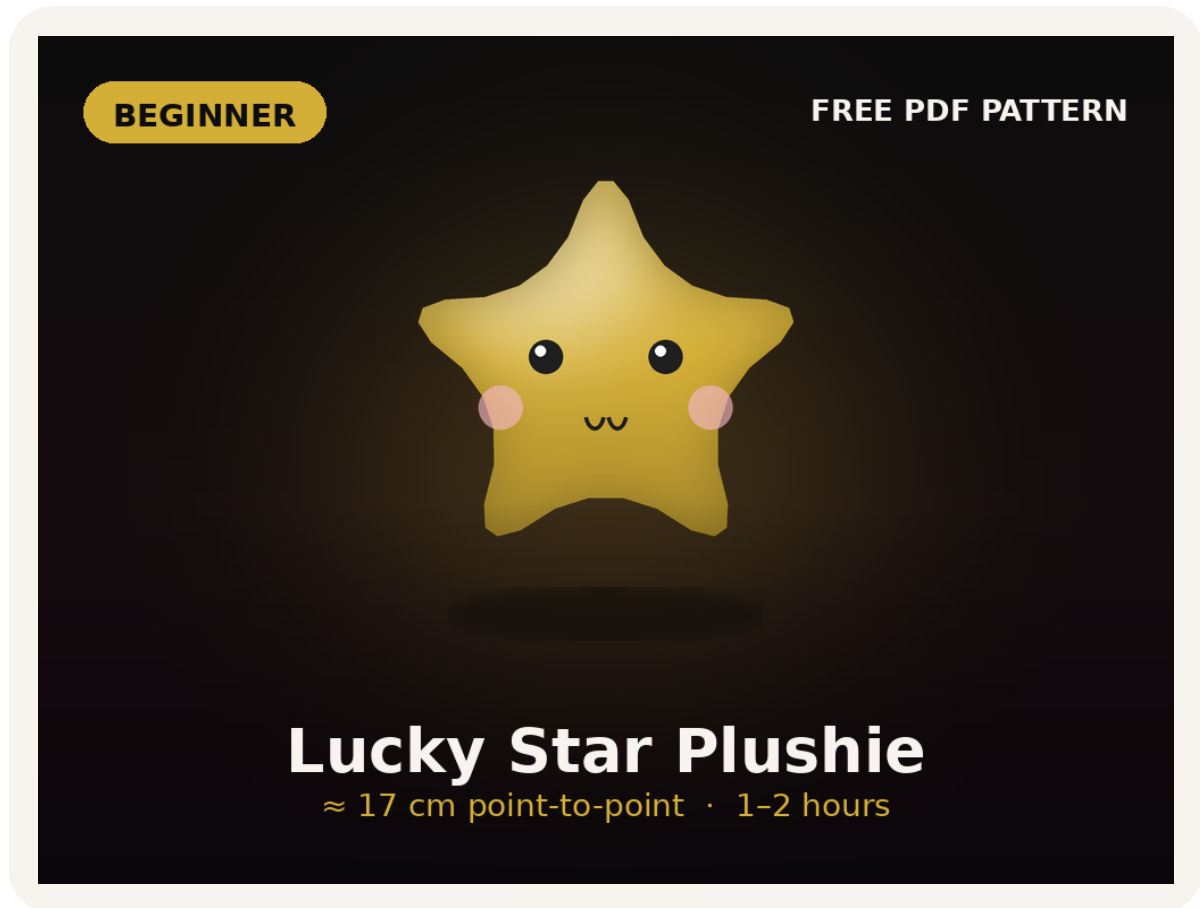

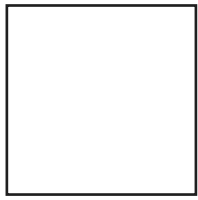


What you'll need

- Fat quarter of felt or fleece (gold/yellow)
- Polyester fiberfill
- Black & pink embroidery floss
- Optional keyring + ribbon loop
- Matching thread

IMPORTANT: Print at 100% (Actual Size). Do NOT 'fit to page'.

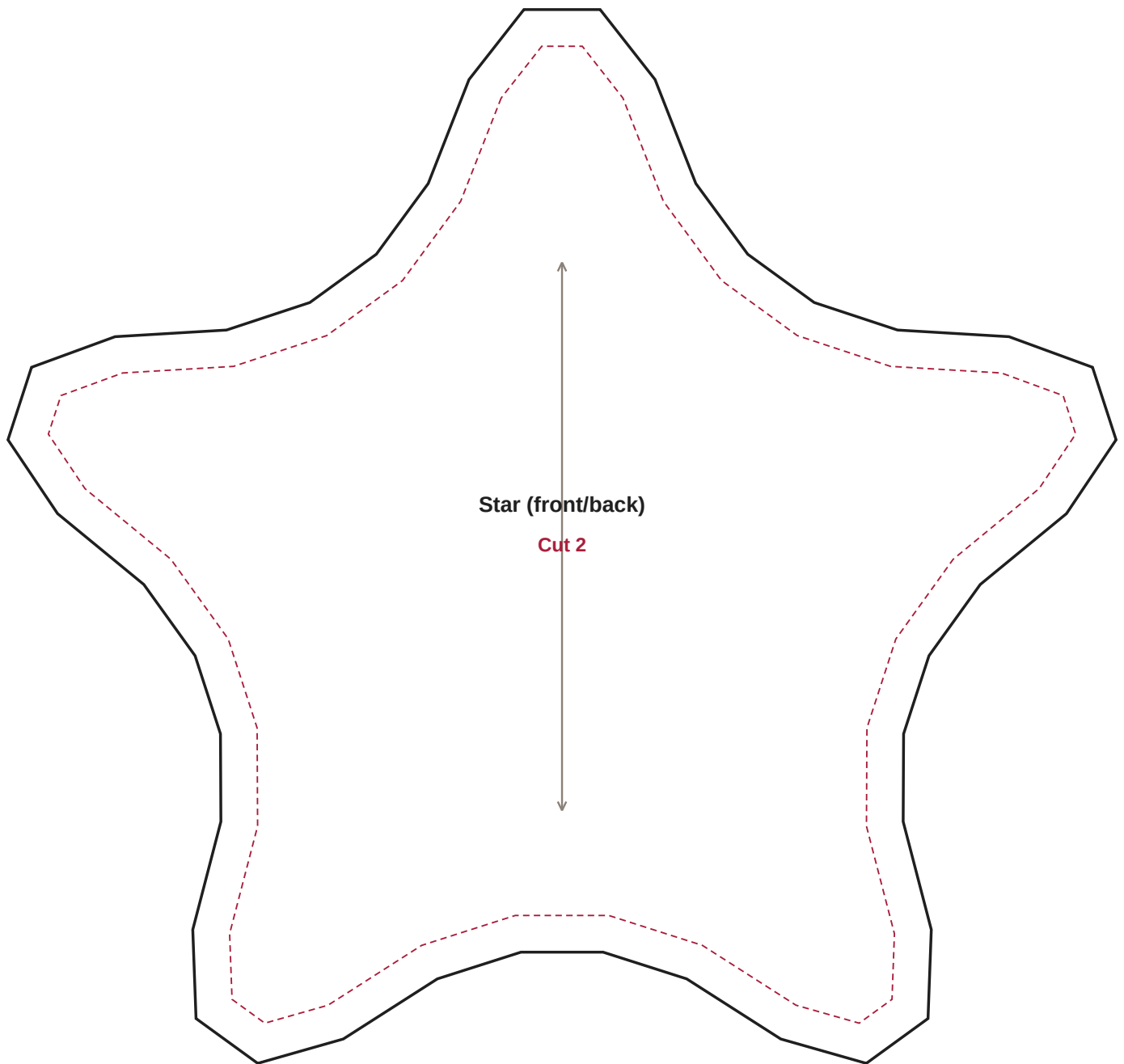
Measure the square below before cutting — it must be exactly 2.5 cm.



2.5 cm × 2.5 cm

KEY

-  Solid line — cut line (6 mm seam allowance included)
-  Dashed line — stitch line, sew along this
-  Notch — line these up when pinning pieces together
-  Grainline — lay parallel to the fabric edge



- 1 Print at 100% and check the 2.5 cm test square.
- 2 Cut 2 star pieces. Embroider the face onto the front now (easier while flat).
- 3 If adding a keyring, baste a folded ribbon loop to one inner point.
- 4 Pin pieces right-sides together; sew around, leaving one edge open between two points.
- 5 Clip into each inner point, then turn right-side out — use a chopstick for the tips.
- 6 Stuff each point first, then the center.
- 7 Ladder-stitch the opening closed.
