The timeless huggable teddy. Six simple pieces, a soft jointed look, and a friendly stitched face. The perfect first plush.

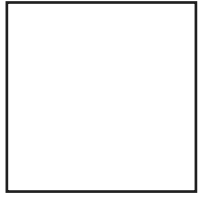


What you'll need

- 1/4 yard (0.25 m) minky or fleece
- Polyester fiberfill stuffing
- Small scraps of cream felt (snout)
- 2 × 12 mm safety eyes (or felt)
- Black embroidery floss (nose & mouth)
- Matching thread, hand or machine

IMPORTANT: Print at 100% (Actual Size). Do NOT 'fit to page'.

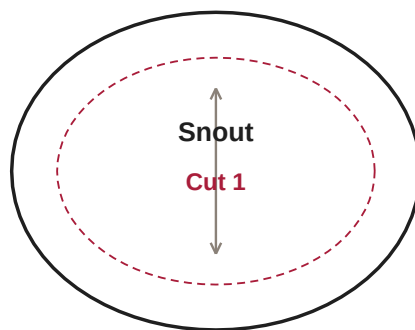
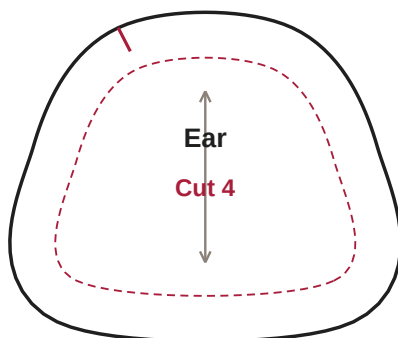
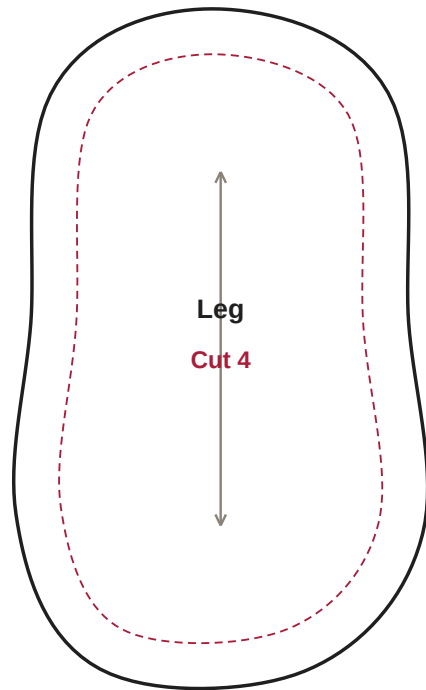
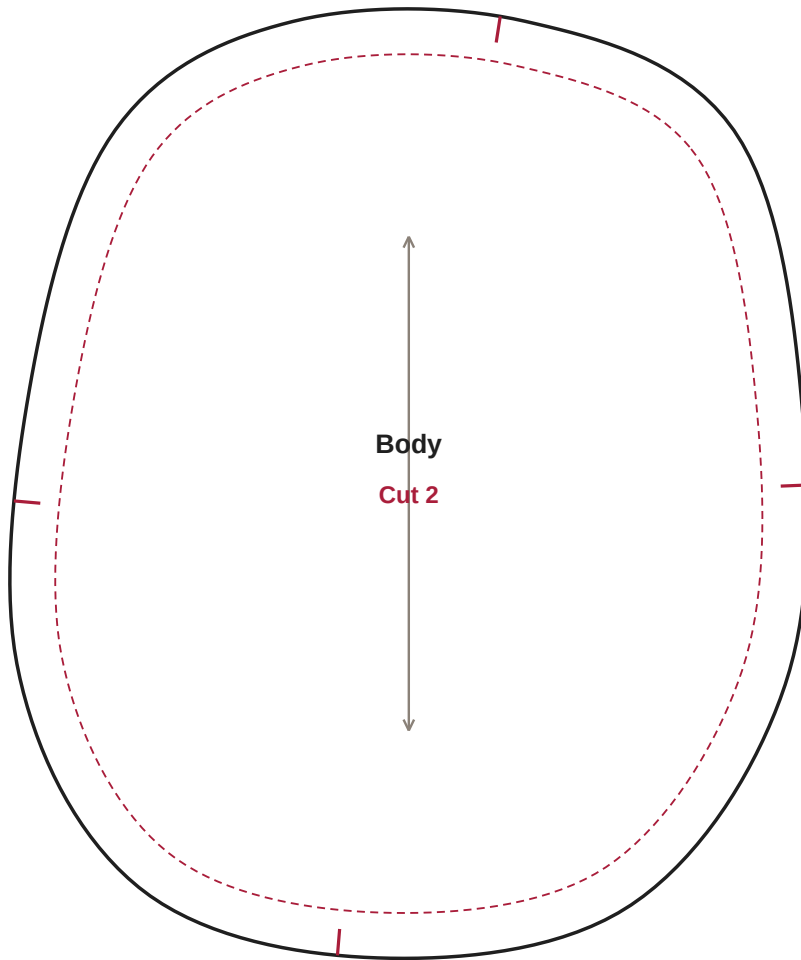
Measure the square below before cutting — it must be exactly 2.5 cm.

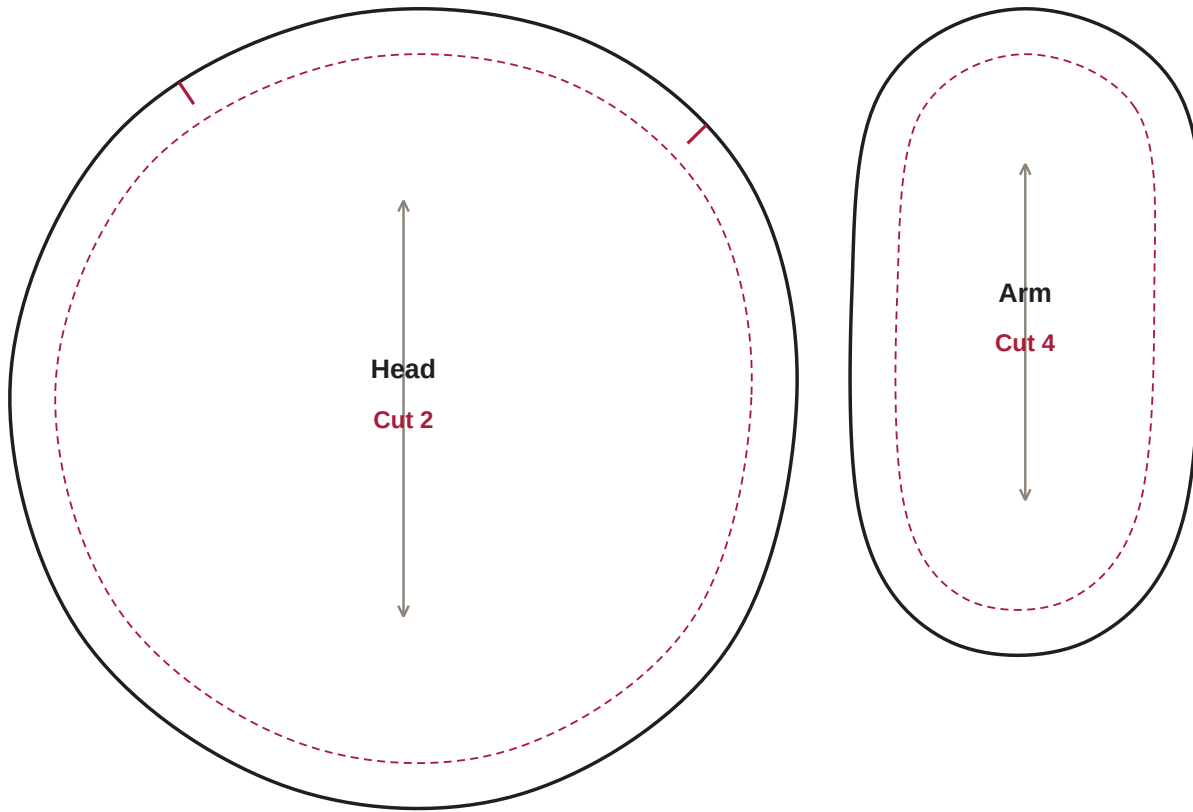


2.5 cm x 2.5 cm

KEY

- Solid line — cut line (6 mm seam allowance included)
- - - Dashed line — stitch line, sew along this
- | Notch — line these up when pinning pieces together
- ↔ Grainline — lay parallel to the fabric edge





- 1 Print at 100% (no scaling). Check the 2.5 cm test square before cutting.
- 2 Cut all pieces from folded fabric so you get mirrored pairs. Transfer all dots and notches.
- 3 Pin and sew each ear pair right-sides together, leaving the straight base open. Turn right-side out.
- 4 Sew the two head pieces together with the ears tucked inside at the marked notches.
- 5 Stitch arms and legs, leaving the top open; turn and lightly stuff.
- 6 Sew the body pieces together, catching arms and legs at the notches, leaving a 5 cm gap in the back.
- 7 Join head to body, turn everything right-side out through the back gap.
- 8 Stuff firmly (head first), then ladder-stitch the gap closed.
- 9 Attach safety eyes, hand-sew the snout, and embroider the nose and a little smile.

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
