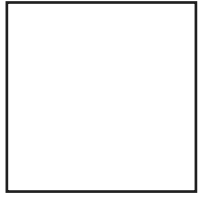


What you'll need

- Red fleece (cap) + cream fleece (stem)
- White felt scraps (spots)
- Polyester fiberfill
- Black & pink floss (face)
- Matching thread

IMPORTANT: Print at 100% (Actual Size). Do NOT 'fit to page'.

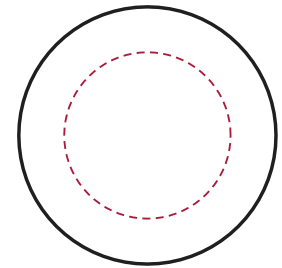
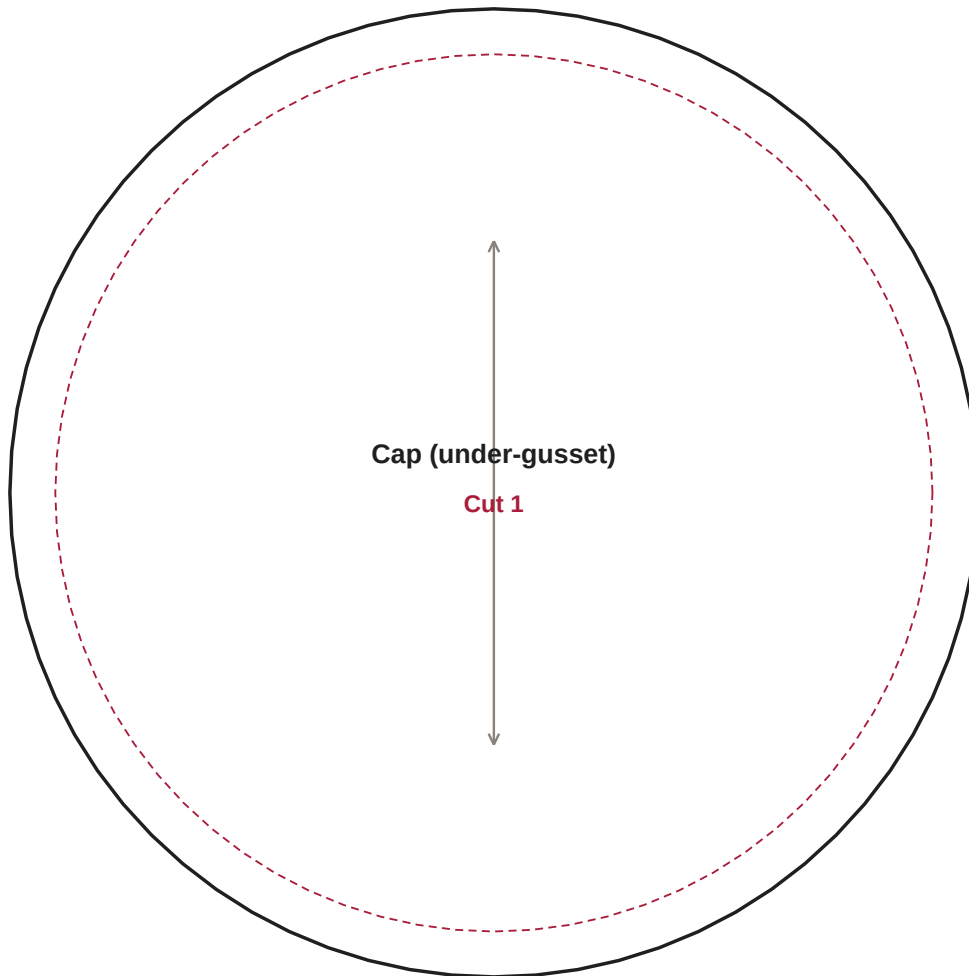
Measure the square below before cutting — it must be exactly 2.5 cm.



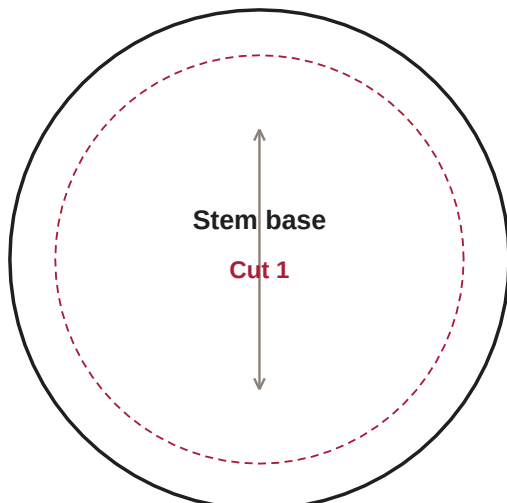
2.5 cm × 2.5 cm

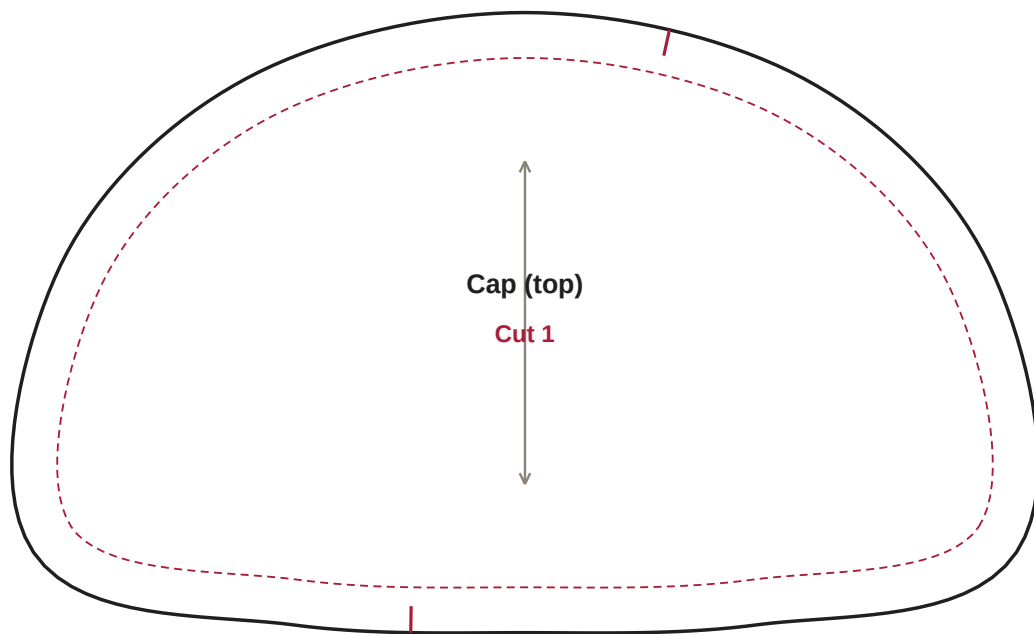
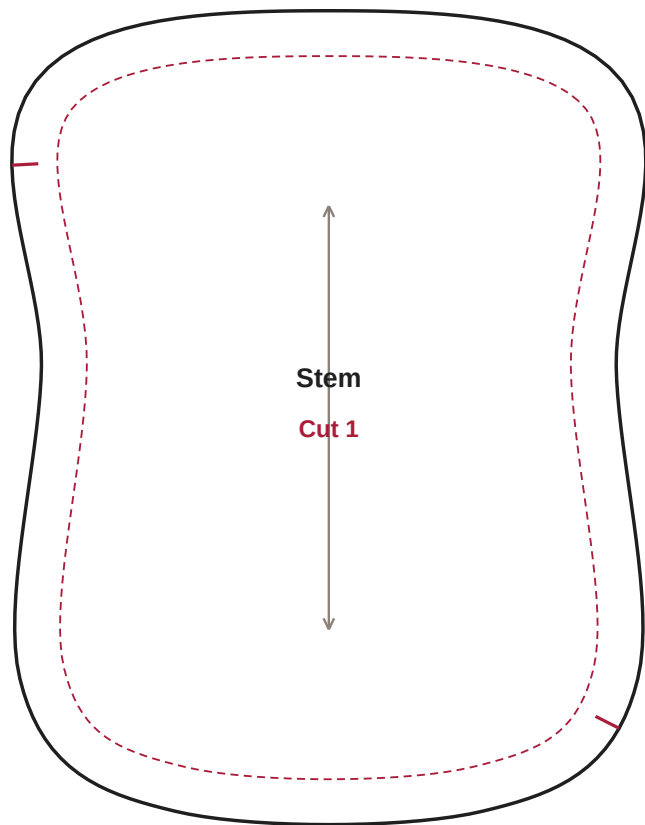
KEY

- Solid line — cut line (6 mm seam allowance included)
- - - Dashed line — stitch line, sew along this
- | Notch — line these up when pinning pieces together
- ↔ Grainline — lay parallel to the fabric edge



Spot · Cut 5





- 1 Print at 100% and confirm the 2.5 cm test square.
- 2 Cut the cap, gusset, stem, base and 5 white spots.
- 3 Appliqué the white spots onto the right side of the cap.
- 4 Sew the cap into a dome, joining it to the curved under-gusset; leave a small gap.
- 5 Stuff the cap firmly through the gap, then close.
- 6 Sew the stem into a tube, insert and sew on the round base; stuff.
- 7 Embroider a cute face on the stem.
- 8 Ladder-stitch the cap onto the top of the stem.

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
